
Suicide Among Adults Aged 35–64 Years — United States, 1999–2010







Tuolumne County Suicide by Age & Gender, 1990-2011








Tuolumne Co and California Suicide Rates, 1990-2012

















Tuolumne County Sucides by Method and Gender, 1990-2012
